Clean, safe water is a fundamental human need. And yet . . .

- 750 million people (about 1 in 9) lack access to safe water.

Polluted water isn't just dirty—it's deadly.

- 1.8 million people die every year from water, sanitation, and hygiene-related causes of diarrheal diseases like cholera.

The Thank You Project wants to make a difference by providing two rural communities in Nigeria (Ututu and Achi) with the equipment and training necessary to dig and maintain fresh water wells.



Our walk will reflect the walk women and children must take every day in these communities (often over 10 miles each way) to collect water from unclean rivers.
