**Clean, safe water is a fundamental human need. And yet . . .**

- 750 million people (about 1 in 9) lack access to safe water.

**Polluted water isn't just dirty—it's deadly.**

- 1.8 million people die every year from diarrheal diseases (including cholera); 90% are children under 5, mostly in developing countries. 88% of diarrheal disease is attributed to unsafe water supply, inadequate sanitation and hygiene. (World Health Organization)

The **Thank You Project** wants to make a difference by providing two rural communities in Nigeria (Ututu and Achi) with the equipment and training necessary to dig and maintain fresh water wells.



Our Walk will reflect the walk women and children must take every day in these communities (often over 10 miles each way) to collect water from unclean rivers.

Walk from Greeley Park to the Concord Street Bridge (approximately one mile) with an empty water container  
Fill water container and return to Greeley Park
